WELCOME TO BATH!

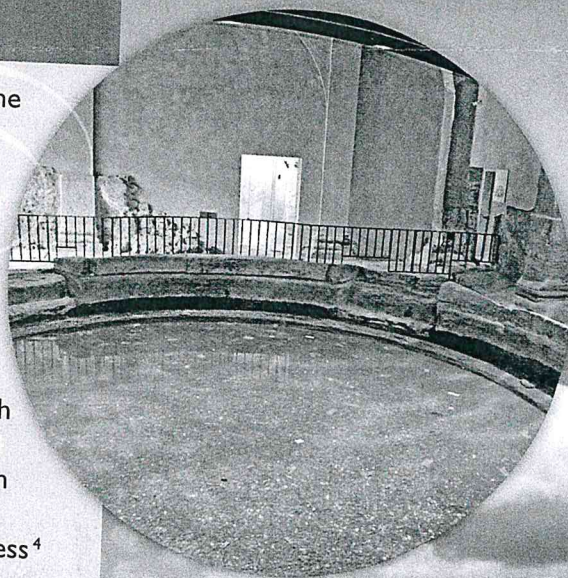

Bath is a beautiful and historic city on the River Avon in the south-west of England. It's a popular tourist destination, but the first visitors arrived in Bath in about AD 70! They travelled to the area for something very special: hot water! Bath has three thermal springs¹ with water at a temperature of about 40° C.

The Romans built the first spa town² in the area in AD 43. They built luxurious³ bath houses near the thermal springs. The bath houses had public baths and swimming pools. Some of them also had restaurants and libraries. Rich and important people travelled to Bath and they swam and relaxed in the bath houses. Today, you can still visit a Roman bath house in the city, but you can't swim in the water!

When the Romans left Britain in AD 410, Bath became less⁴ important. In 1702 the British queen, Queen Anne, visited Bath and she swam in the spa waters. This was the start of a magnificent revival⁵ for the city. A lot of rich and famous people wanted to live in the city, and architects designed beautiful houses for them. One of its famous residents was the English writer Jane Austen. There are a lot of important historical buildings in Bath. The Pump House is one of them. In the past, people went there to drink the hot water from the thermal springs. Today the Pump House is an elegant café. You can buy a glass of hot spa water in the café. Everybody tries it, but very few people drink it all ... it contains 43 different minerals and it has a very unusual taste⁶.
